Our Approach

The International Aid Transparency Initiative (IATI) is a voluntary, multi-stakeholder initiative that seeks to improve the transparency of aid, development, and humanitarian resources to increase their effectiveness in tackling poverty. The United Nations Foundation (UNF) is committed to transparency and open information, and thus publishes data about the organization and its activities in line with the standards of the IATI. UNF's approach is aligned with its donors' requirements and its internal capacity and resources for publishing to IATI. In line with the IATI Standards, UNF publishes organizational data annually, and activity data quarterly when requested by its donors for the specific activities funded by the donor. UNF's data covers data from November 1, 2017 onward.

Our Data

At the organizational data:

- Name of the organization
- Organizational identifier
- Organization type
- Total budget
- Total expenditure

At the activity data:

- Activity identification number
- Activity title, status, sector and location
- Activity duration
- Activity description and objectives
- Activity funding organization
- Activity implementing organization
- Activity incoming funds and disbursements
